This letter is in response to your letter dated 26 May 1992 to Mr. Piero Maggiacomo regarding the above mentioned site. Your letter stated that 3 (three) items needed to be addressed within 30 days of receipt of your letter. The following responses are in the same order as they were presented in your 26 May 1992 letter:

- 1. Mr Maggiacomo has informed Triangle Environmental that all related piping to the existing 10,000 gallon underground storage tank will be removed and capped at the tank. The tank will then be precision tested. The precision test will completed within 2 (two) weeks. Your office will be notified of the date of precision testing.
- 2. After further review of the subject property it appears that there is a second underground storage tank in the vicinity of the aforementioned 10,000 gallon tank. The piping for the 10,000 gallon underground storage tank, which will be removed, also appears to be above the second underground storage tank. During excavation of the underground piping, the location and size of the second tank can be exposed. At that time any other exploratory work around the tank will be discussed. This work will be performed prior to the precision testing of the 10,000 gallon tank. Your office will be notified of the excavation work so that a representative from your office may be present if necessary.
- As you may already be aware, Triangle Engineering has been retained to provide their services for further investigation work on the subject property.
