The Office of Waste Management has reviewed Site Investigation Report dated August 2004 that was submitted by your consultant GZA. The data that has been provided is deemed to satisfy the applicable soil and groundwater standards. Therefore, the Department is requiring no further action with regard to the impacts from the former USTs at this site. If excavation is done at the site in the future in the vicinity of the release, any contaminated soil encountered must be managed in accordance with RIDEM Oil Pollution Control Regulations and Rules and Regulations for Solid Waste Management Facilities.

The groundwater monitoring wells must be closed in accordance with Section 13.0, Appendix of the RIDEM Rules and Regulations for Groundwater Quality, as amended July 1993. <u>The</u> <u>Department of Environmental Management reserves the right to require additional investigation and/or remedial action if in the future significant contamination attributable to this site is discovered or if the land use changes.</u>
